

Rotary Foundation Fun Day/Fundraiser Rescheduled for April 30, 2005

The Rotary Foundation fun day and fundraiser will be held on April 30, 2005. Join Rotarians from throughout our District for a picnic and BBQ and celebration of another great Rotary year. Raffle and silent auction to benefit Rotary International.

Rotary International Convention, Chicago June 18-22, 2005 Travel via Train. Here's another fun way to travel to the Chicago convention. Join District 5170 Rotarians and take a 3 day / 2 night train ride to Chicago on the California Zephyr and fly home after the Convention. Experienced travelers say it's the most beautiful train trip in America. Amtrak's California Zephyr allows you to follow the trail of pioneers and the Pony Express along America's earliest transcontinental rail route, from Emeryville, California, over the Sierras through Nevada, Utah, the Rockies, Colorado, Nebraska, Iowa, and Illinois to Chicago. Return via Air to SFO. Coach Seats \$299 per person, Standard Sleeper \$549 per person, and Deluxe Sleeper \$799 are available. District Governor Mike recommends Deluxe Sleeper, and will be traveling both ways via the train.

Hotel Reservations. RI recommends that individual Rotarians looking for hotel reservations contact "One-Stop Chicago", the housing bureau, as the best source for downtown hotel reservations. The hotels do have rooms remaining, but can not accommodate requests for large blocks of rooms any longer. The telephone number provided for One-Stop Chicago is 1-847-282-2529.

For those traveling as a group, the best option is to search for hotels in the O'Hare airport area. There will be shuttle transportation to the convention locations downtown. There are some very fine options in the \$129-\$169/ night range at O'Hare, including a Hyatt (\$169), Sofitel (\$169), Embassy Suites (\$140, including breakfast), Westin (\$154), and Holiday Inn and Best Western (\$129/\$139).
